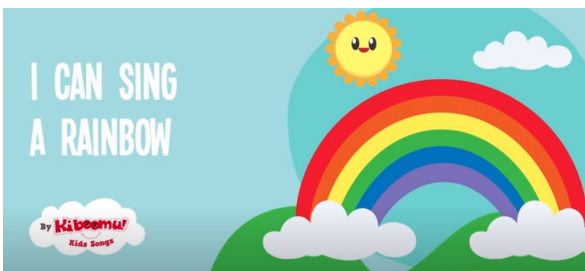

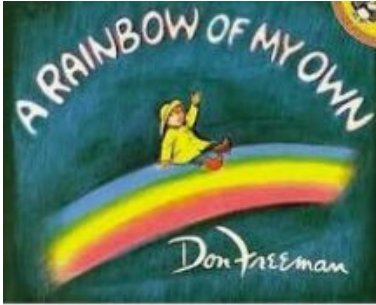

Centers

Art : Watercolor umbrellas

Materials:

- + Coffee filters
- + Colored markers
- + Spray bottle
- + Construction paper
- + Scissors
- + Glue stick

Instructions:

1. Fold coffee filters in half.
2. Have your little one color away with the markers all over the coffee filters. Encourage use of all colors to create a more colorful end result.
3. Spray coffee filter with spray bottle of water until fully saturated.
4. Let dry. (We let ours dry over-night and did the second half of the craft the next day.)
5. Cut out umbrella handles from the construction paper.
6. Glue the two sides of the umbrella/coffee filter together.
7. And glue the umbrella handle to the umbrella!



Math: Our number this month is 9, Can you make the #9? (Hint - make a circle & make a line, than connect them together)

Activity/Game:

Make RAINBOW crayons

Supplies needed:

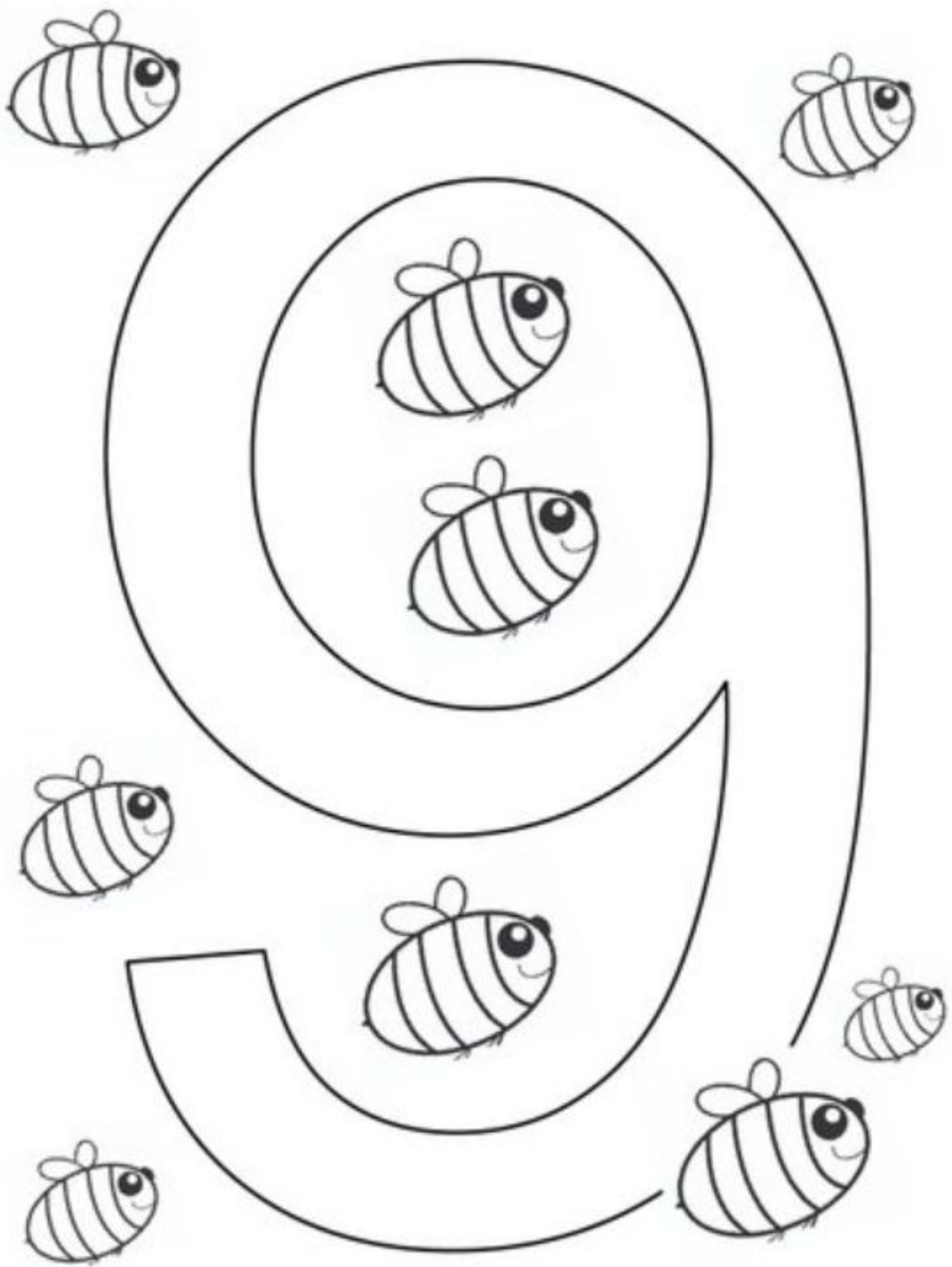
- Unwrapped Crayons of various colors (highly recommend using only Crayola Brand)
- Muffin Tin or Silicone Molds designed for high heat.
- Skewer to swirl colors and achieve a different effect
- Oven or toaster oven

Directions:

- Peel wrappers off crayons.
- Break into thirds or fourths if not broken already.
- Sort into muffin tins. I like about 2 layers of crayon although a single layer works too.
- Place in toaster oven or oven at 200 for approximately 10 minutes or until melted. Wax CAN burn so you need to know your oven. If your oven runs hot reduce heat to 170 and lengthen time to 15 minutes.
- I stirred a few with a skewer to get different results.
- Remove from oven. Let cool and pop out of tin.
