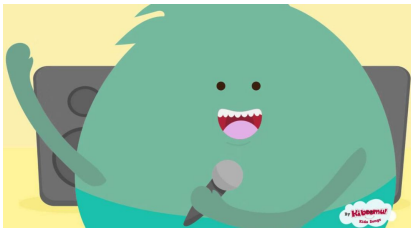

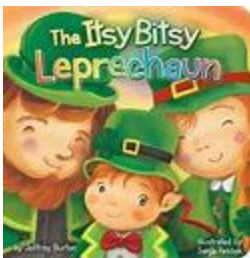
Art : Color and cut out the shamrock, once this is completed use the shamrock to play a short game after the Read-a-Long at the end of the day.

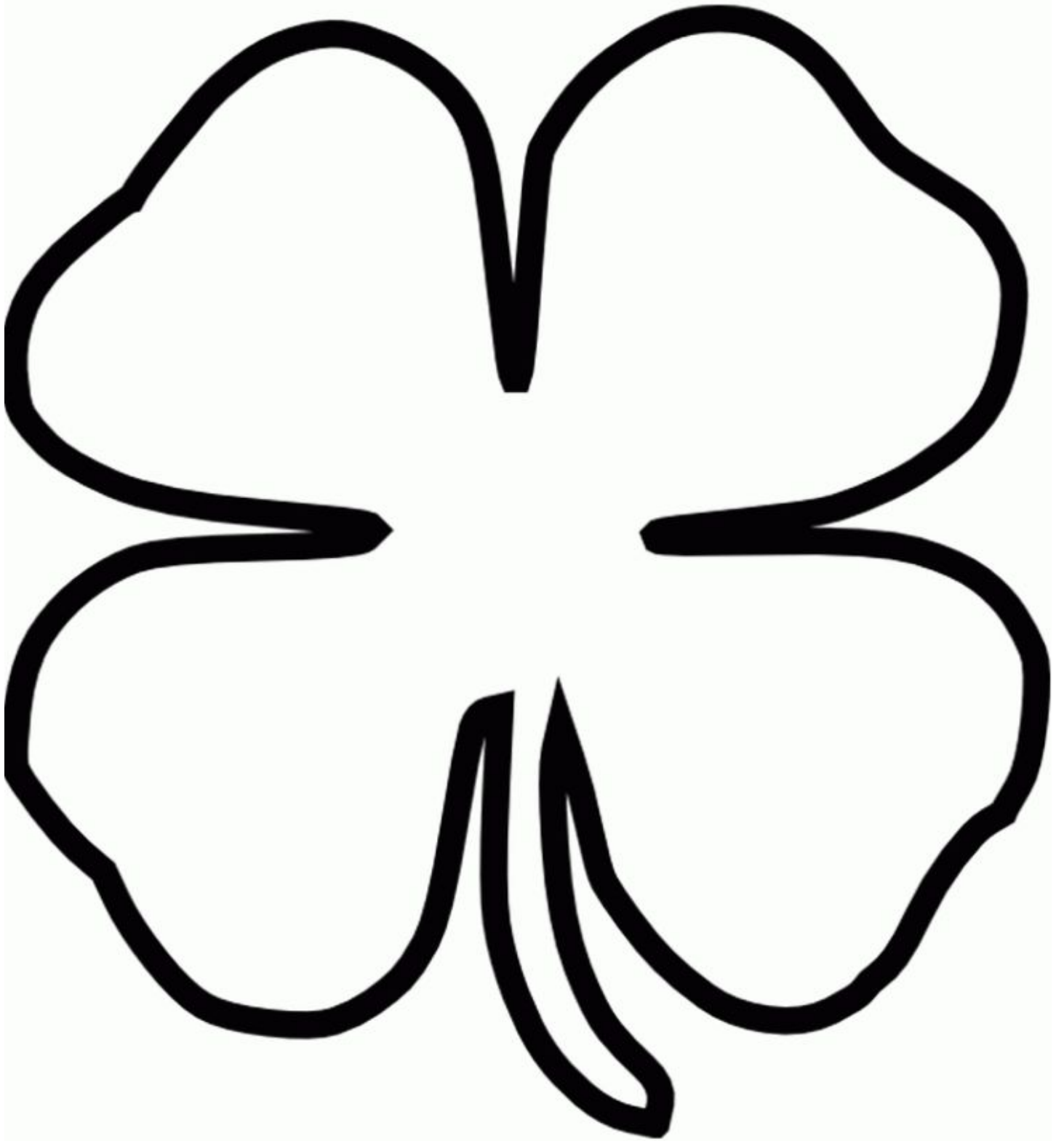

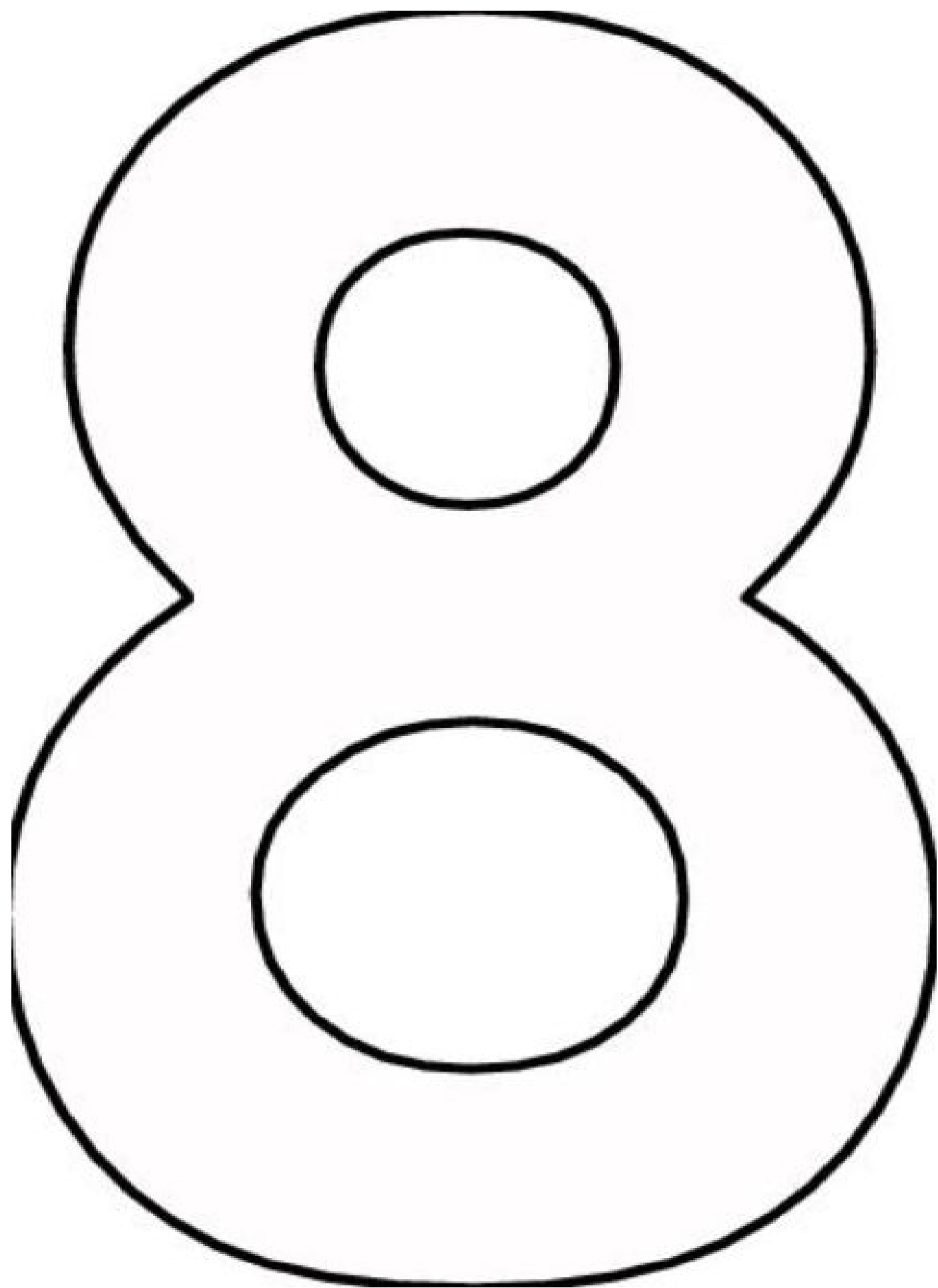
