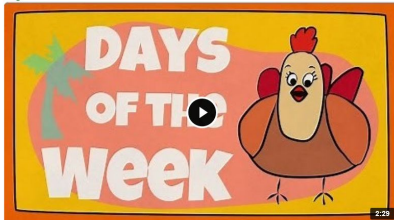

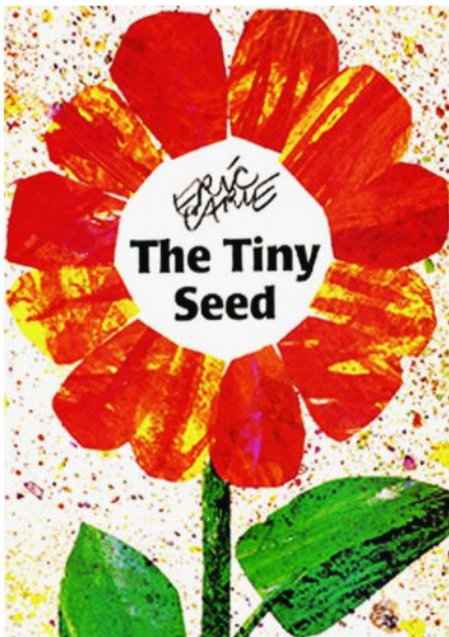

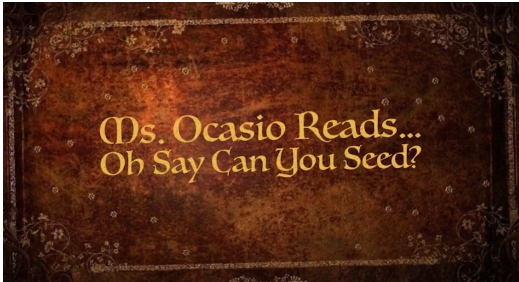

THE PARTS OF A PLANT

Activity:

Grow A Lima Bean In A Ziplock Bag



Instructions -

1. Wet a paper towel
2. Lay 2 or 3 Lima Beans in single layer on the paper towel.
3. Fold the paper towel to cover up the beans.
4. Slide the moistened paper towel with the beans between them into a plastic zippered bag.
5. Seal the zippered bag tight. Leave some air inside the bag to aid in the germination process.
6. Place the sealed bag on a windowsill to allow the beans to stay warm and receive plenty of sunlight.
7. Check the beans every day, keep the paper towel moist. When needed spray the paper towel with water using a water bottle.
8. The beans should begin to pop open within 24 - 48 hours.
9. Green shoots should begin sprouting from the roots a few days later.
